

## COMMENDATIONS – Total 4 (Unranked)

### C2FA2CCC

The project is approached strategically with the theme of reciprocity at its core. The theme of reciprocity was carried through the project as a conceptual touchstone embracing values of governance as well as structural principles. Whilst many of the submissions worked to create scenographically impactful and iconic propositions this entry constructed a network of paths and routes within the park incorporating a mixture of passive and active recreational uses into which the proposed structure was thoughtfully integrated. Useful references and precedents were provided to conceptually situate the project as an appropriate, welcome and distinctively regionalist response to the brief. The project showed promise in terms of how the various dimensions of the concept might be subsequently developed and was both diverse and generous in its scope and ambition.

The merits of the project were discussed at some length and it was agreed by the jury that whilst not evidently as visually impactful as some of the entries, that the project distinguished itself in its sensitivity and generosity and that in particular would offer unique, familiar and humane qualities both as a considered and artfully fashioned work of architecture as well as, significantly, through habitual use over time.
